Create a Scavenger Hunt

Grab a Lego set or Play-Doh from the Warm and Fuzzy Closet and work on building something incredible together! Maybe you and your assigned CASA youth sketch a blueprint before you begin. Maybe you build a shelter for their toys and stuffed animals. Maybe you add something new to your building/sculpture at every visit!



Games

Bring a board game or deck of cards from home!

Have a favorite game that you'd like to introduce to your assigned CASA child/youth? Bring it to your visit! Play a board game or cards at their house, the library, a restaurant, or the CASA office!



CASA's Little Library

Curl up with a good book!

Stop by the CASA office to visit the Little Library! Curl up with a good book or two of your assigned CASA youth's choice. Maybe you grab a snack, a drink, and a toy from the Warm & Fuzzy Closet while you're there as well!



DIY Hot Cocoa Bar

Stop by the store for instant hot cocoa and toppings (marshmallows, candy canes, whipped cream, sprinkles, etc.). Set everything up for your assigned CASA youth and let them make their own delicious masterpiece!



Write a Play, a Story, or Choreograph a Dance

Dance, sing, act, & imagine!

Use your imagination to write a play, a story, or to come up with a dance. Let your CASA youth take the lead! Choose who you would like to perform it for (parents, foster parents, GAL, siblings, etc.) and begin planning a mini event! Maybe you make costumes, decorate a space, and create invitations! This will give you both something new to look forward to.
